

Justice Prof. **Elyakim Rubinstein**

Justice Prof. **Elyakim Rubinstein** is a former Justice and Deputy President of the Supreme Court of Israel, Attorney General and Government Secretary, as well as Legal Advisor to the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Defense. He participated in peace negotiations with all of Israel's neighbors: Egyptian, Lebanese, Jordanian, Palestinian and Syrian. Inter alia he was a member of the Israeli delegations to the Camp David Accords and the Treaty of Peace with Egypt (1978/9), the autonomy and normalization agreements with Egypt (1979-82), the Israel-Lebanon agreement (1983), the Madrid Conference (1991). He served as chair of the Israeli Delegation to the negotiations with the Jordanians and Palestinians in Madrid and Washington (1991-1993), Head of the delegation to the Treaty of Peace with Jordan and implementation agreements (1994-1995). After retiring, he was a professor of political studies and public policy in the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and chair of a number of public committees, including the Ministry of Justice Committee on the fight against racism. Until recently, he served as President of the Israeli Society of Public Law. He is currently the President of the Ashkelon Academic College, President of the Council for Conservation of Heritage Sites in Israel (since 2023), and an IJL board member.
